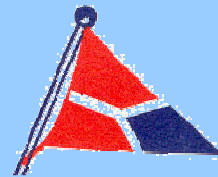

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER'S REPORT

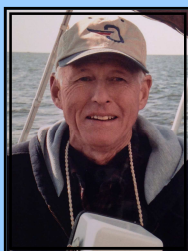

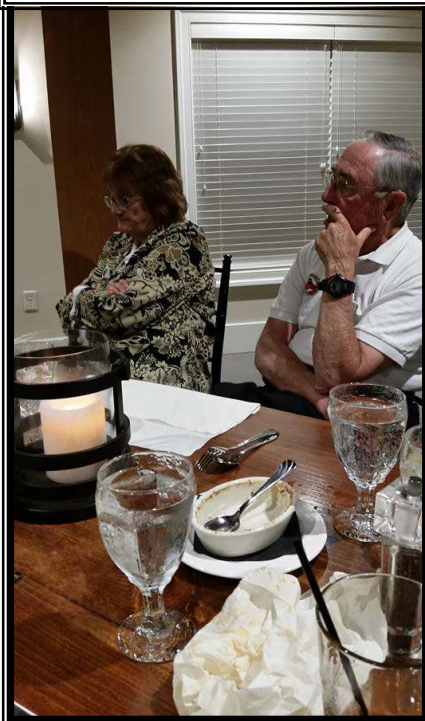


We were privileged to have D/5 District Commander Randy Stow and wife Judy at our COW in February 2017.

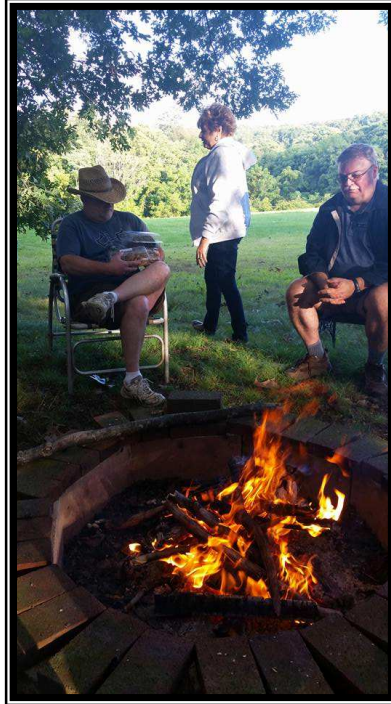
