






BOATING THROUGH EDUCATION

"Captain Lou" Lowell William Schroder of New Bern died Friday, September 19, 2008, just days before his 65th birthday. Captain Schroder was born on September 24, 1943 in Avon, SD to the late William B. and Henrietta Giedd Schroder. He retired at 46 from a career as an electrical engineer. After retirement he was a Captain for Lauahline River Tours, Lake Mead Cruises and a part-time barge Captain for Foley & Foley Dock Builders. He was currently Captain of a Hatteras-Ocracoke Ferry and a member of the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla 20-05. He served his country in the US Air Force and received his license as a Merchant Marine Captain. He had also worked as a corporate pilot for 11 years with Mid-America Web Press. Captain Schroder was Founder/President of Lowell Manufacturing Company Inc., and Seafair Industries in Red Lion, PA. A Celebration of Life was held on Wednesday, September 24 at Cotton Chapel.
